



Rabbit Rescue/Trap Checker Volunteer



As a rescue, wrangling loose domestic rabbits is an inherent part of the job. Depending on the situation, we do this with a group of people armed with portable pens and nets or with baited, strategically-placed live traps. Live traps require consistent checking, the frequency of which is determined by the weather, location, and urgency of the situation. We are seeking volunteers that are willing to go on a "call list" for when we need assistance with rescues. We do try to match trap location with volunteer location. All training provided.

Requirements

- Must be 18 years of age or older
- Must have a reliable vehicle and cell phone
- Up-to-date tetanus vaccination (record required within 30 days)
- Must be physically agile and able to carry a rabbit (can weigh up to 15 pounds)
 Does not apply if acting only as trap checker
- Ability to interact with animals safely
- Demonstrated understanding of the importance of rescuing domestic rabbits
- Demonstrated understanding that animal rescues do not always have happy endings
